

I have sent this Alert to all those on either the TWRA or Neighbourhood Watch distribution lists. It includes an updated version of the Events List.

This alert has been issued to advise residents of the existence of a planning application for a residential caravan site and other facilities to be sited alongside Chequers Lane. This proposal has raised significant concern within the local community. As this is a fast moving situation the alert's main purpose is to inform those of you who are not already aware of it and to direct you to the TWRA web site [www.twra.org.uk/news](http://www.twra.org.uk/news) where regular updates will be posted. The following is an extract from the current introductory section from the web site and in the Events section below you will see details of the Public meeting which has been arranged to allow residents to input their views to a working party which has been formed by TWRA, Walton Forum and Heath Drive RA.

#### **Planning application [23/02680](#) Caravan Site for 3 residential pitches, Chequers Lane, Walton on the Hill**

"The TWRA, Walton Forum and Heath Drive RA have established a Working Party to respond to the application on behalf of the village community and assist those who want to make their own comments."

The web site then lists the major planning issues that the Working Party has so far identified associated with the application and states that:

"The Working Party has organised a public meeting on 29 January at the Riddell Hall, doors open at 7.15 pm, where further information will be provided. However, its main aim is to give you the opportunity to ask questions of Working Party members and let us know your views."
