#### **Chequers Lane Working Party (CLWP) Update**

This paragraph concerns the working party, consisting of representatives from TWRA, Walton Village Forum and Heath drive RA, which was formed to make representations to the planning authorities with respect to the planning application to create both permanent and temporary births for caravans in a field alongside Chequers Lane.

CLWP held a first Public Meeting on this issue on January 29<sup>th</sup>. They are now calling a second on **Monday evening 15<sup>th</sup> April, in the Riddell Hall, doors opening at 7pm with the meeting starting at 7.30pm. All residents are invited to attend.
