The planning application for installation of three permanent and three temporary caravan pitches in a field alongside Chequers Lane which was turned down by Reigate & Banstead Council some months ago has been appealed.

This will now also be an opportunity for residents to be informed of the basis on which the appeal has been made and what actions are open for representations to be made to the Appeal Hearing which is due to take place starting 4th February 2025.
