Crowds will be forming in the High street from 3.30pm onwards – a Tadworth Primary School Choir will sing carols from 4pm and the Mayor will switch on the Christmas Lights at 4.30pm. Activity moves on to Station Approach with the Good Shepherd Nativity Scene illuminated at 4.45pm with carols by the Good Shepherd Choir. Various shops will be offering refreshments, including Cross Road, so activities will continue during the early evening. Tickets will be on sale for the Tadworth Grand Raffle during the event with many marvellous prizes donated by local businesses and other benefactors.
